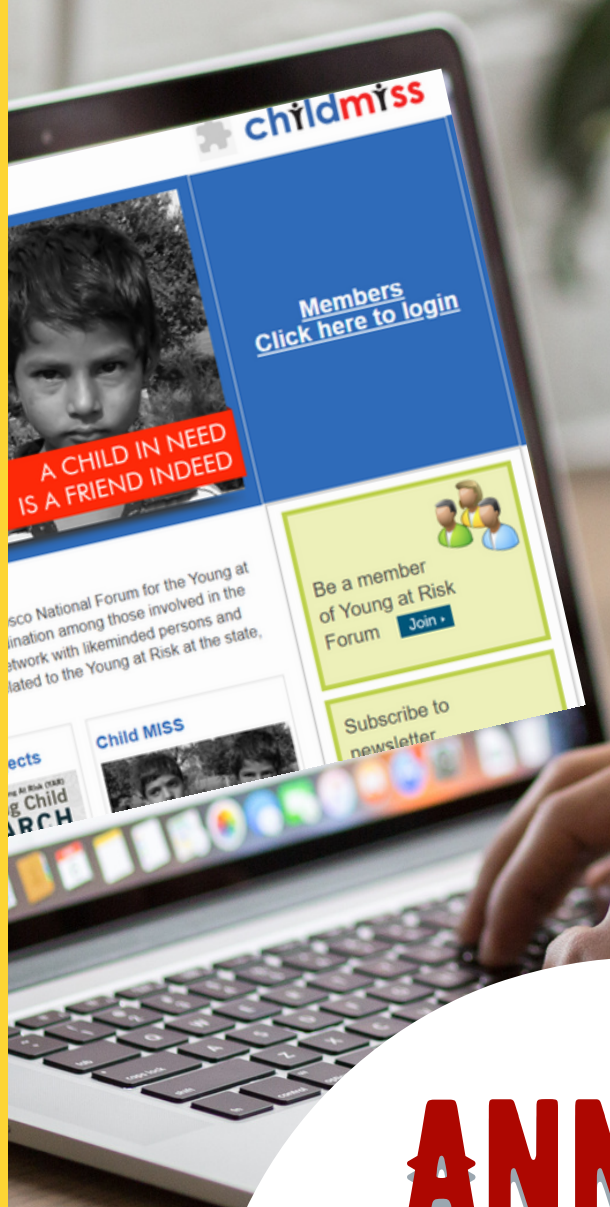

Every organization registered on the Child-MISS website is providing various services like education, vocational training, health care, etc. The children have the freedom to choose what they really want to do. Though the government has a separate system to look after the children at risk, they never concentrate on these issues. So we end up doing what the government should be doing by providing the child with basic necessities.

As a Hub Coordinator, I have been monitoring these works but we found that even we are making some mistakes. We are not being able to make the child trust us. We are not able to send the child to his/her parents who will be crying from the day their child ran away from home. This has to happen if we are to give the best to the Children. I hope that this might change in the future so that no child would be on the street. I pray that this happens at the earliest.

There is a saying "Today's Actions decide tomorrow's happenings". So let's do our best in action rather than in words and see better changes in the future.

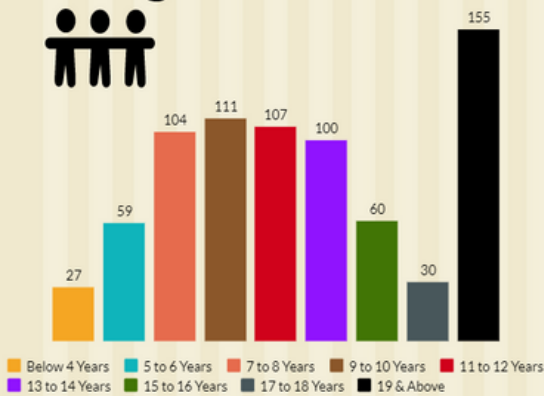

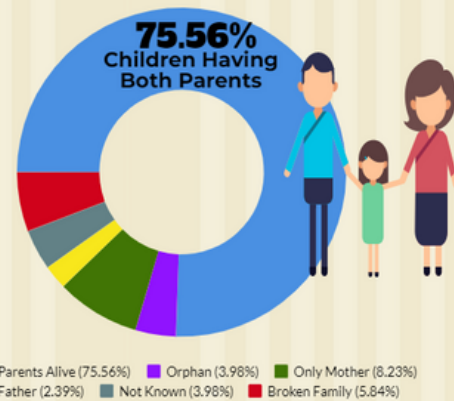

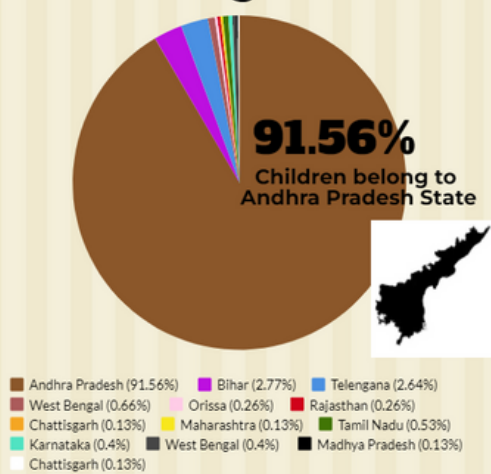
## Age Distribution



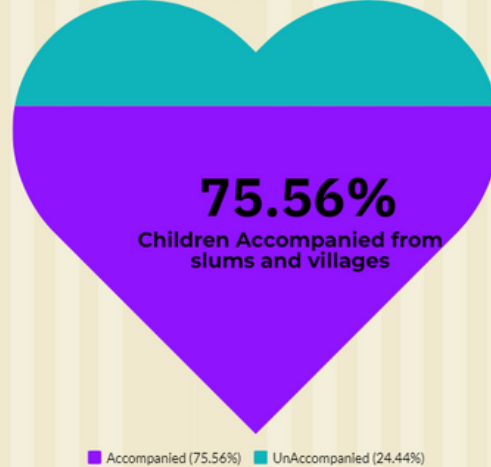
## Parental Status



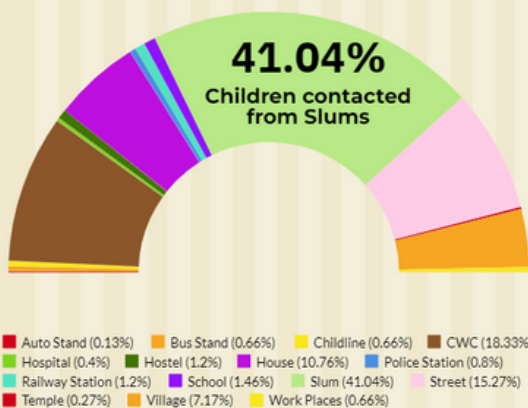

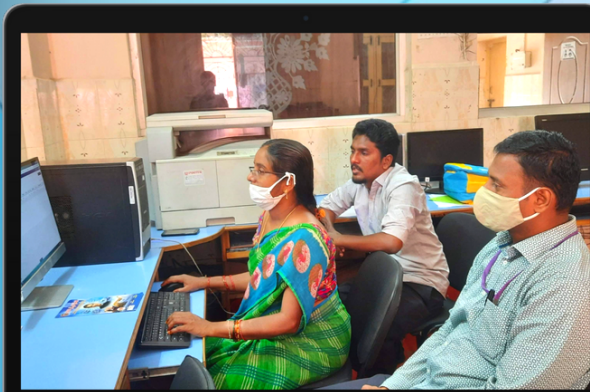
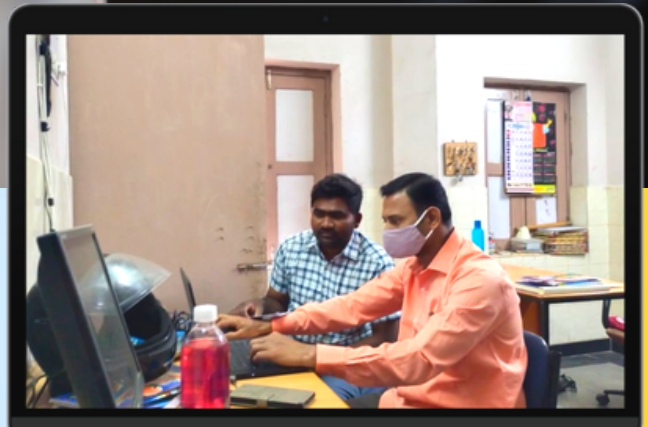
# Visits & Hands-on Training

**Visited DB Navjeevan-Kurnool to identify the child's profiles and registers after the verification, entered and updated the data in the Child-MISS tool.**



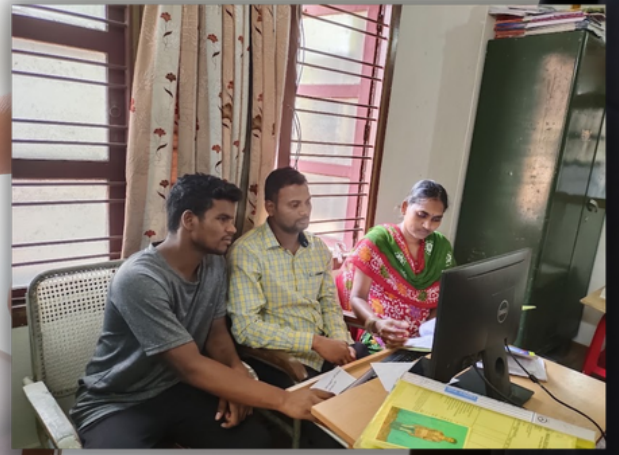
**Visited DB Navjeevan-Hyderabad and gave hands-on training to 2 persons on the Child-MISS tool to update the child's profile data and all the registers.**

**Visited DB Navjeevan-Visakhapatnam to update the profiles of slum children, Vocational students and verified all child profiles & registers.**



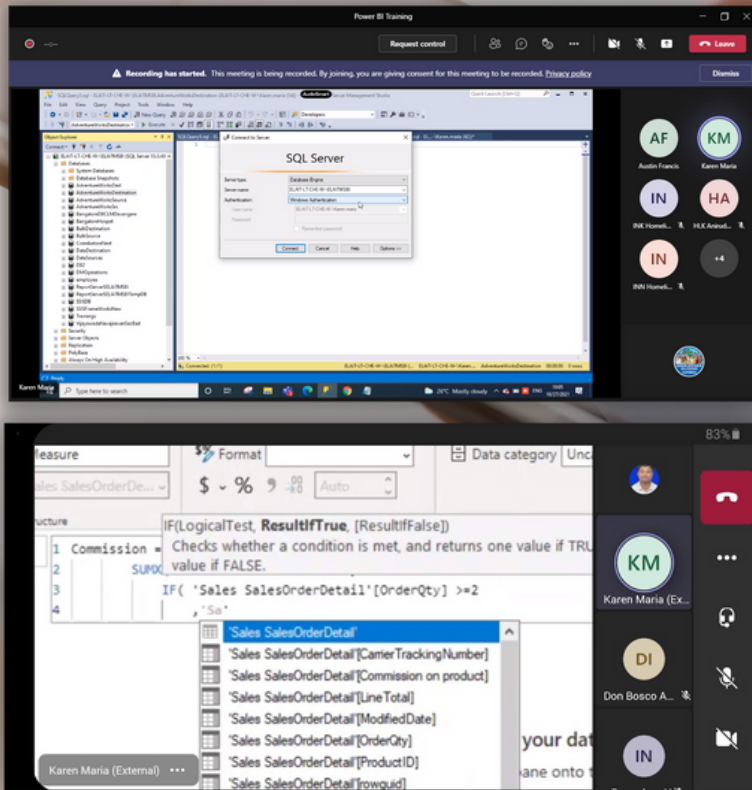

# TRAINING ON POWER BI



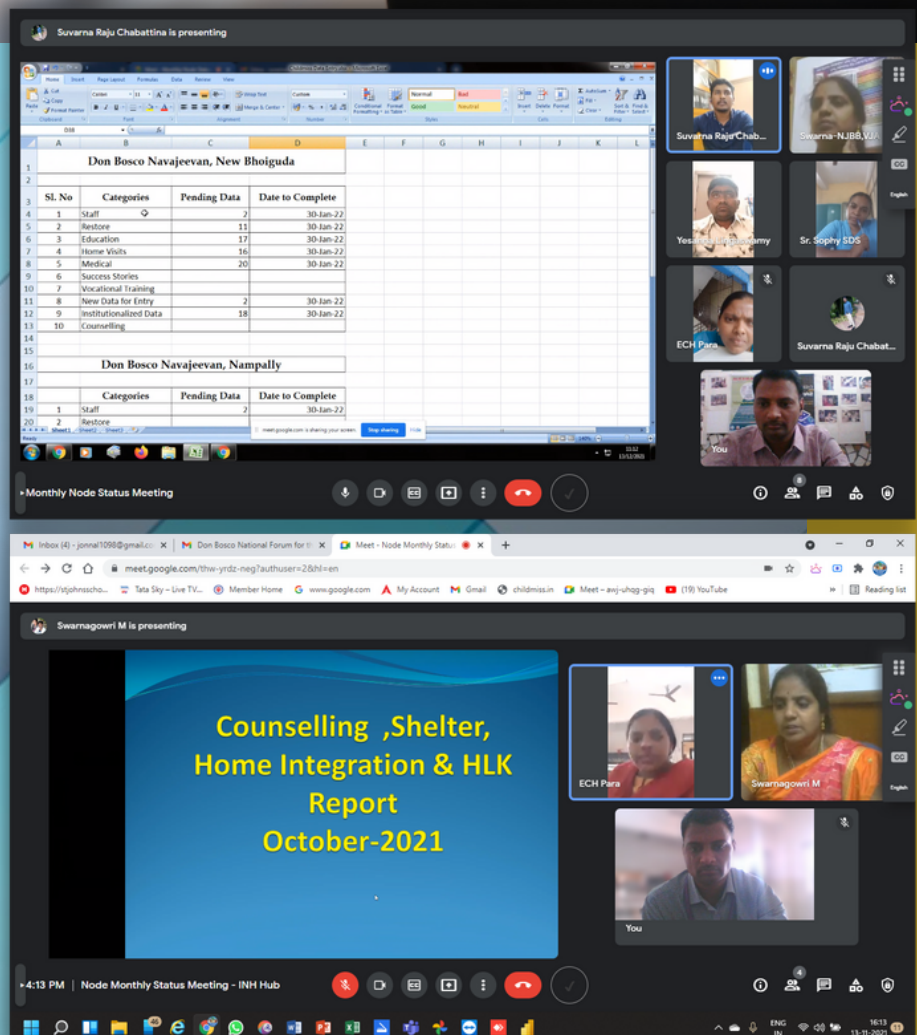

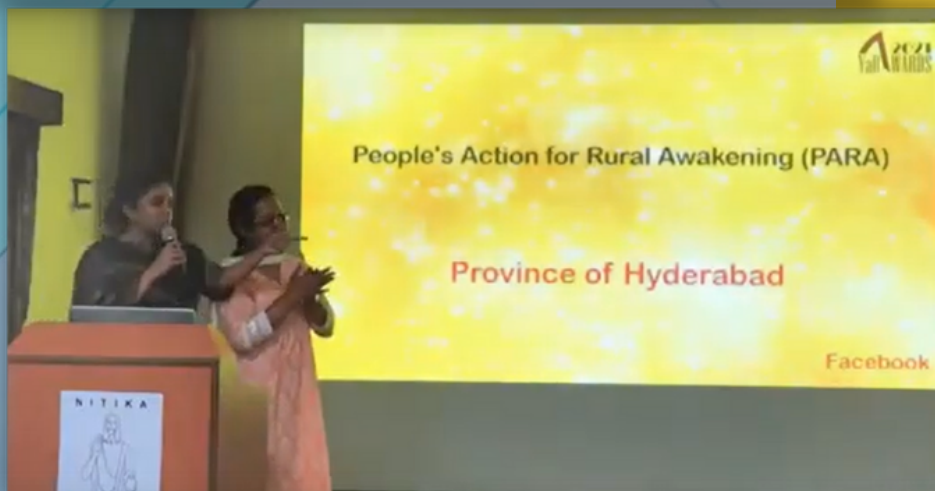
