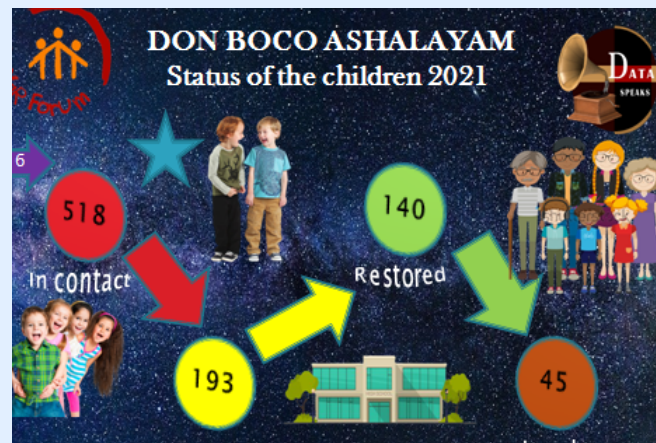
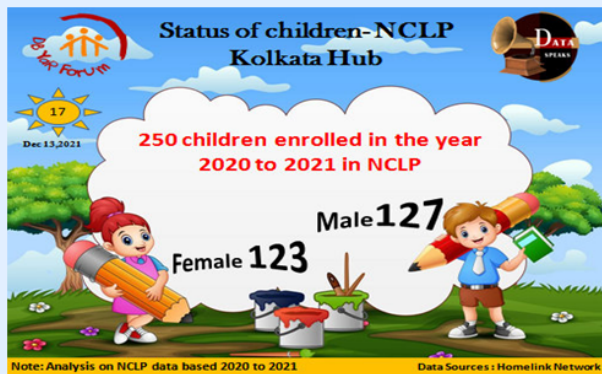




# Snippets

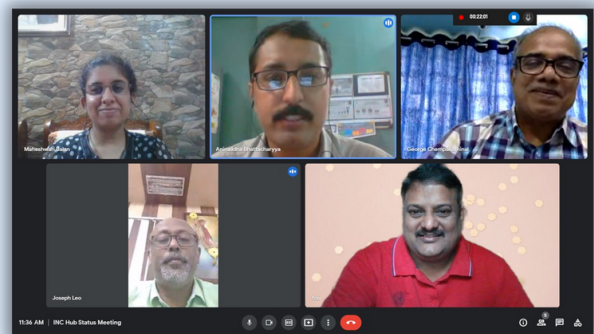
