2. FROZEN



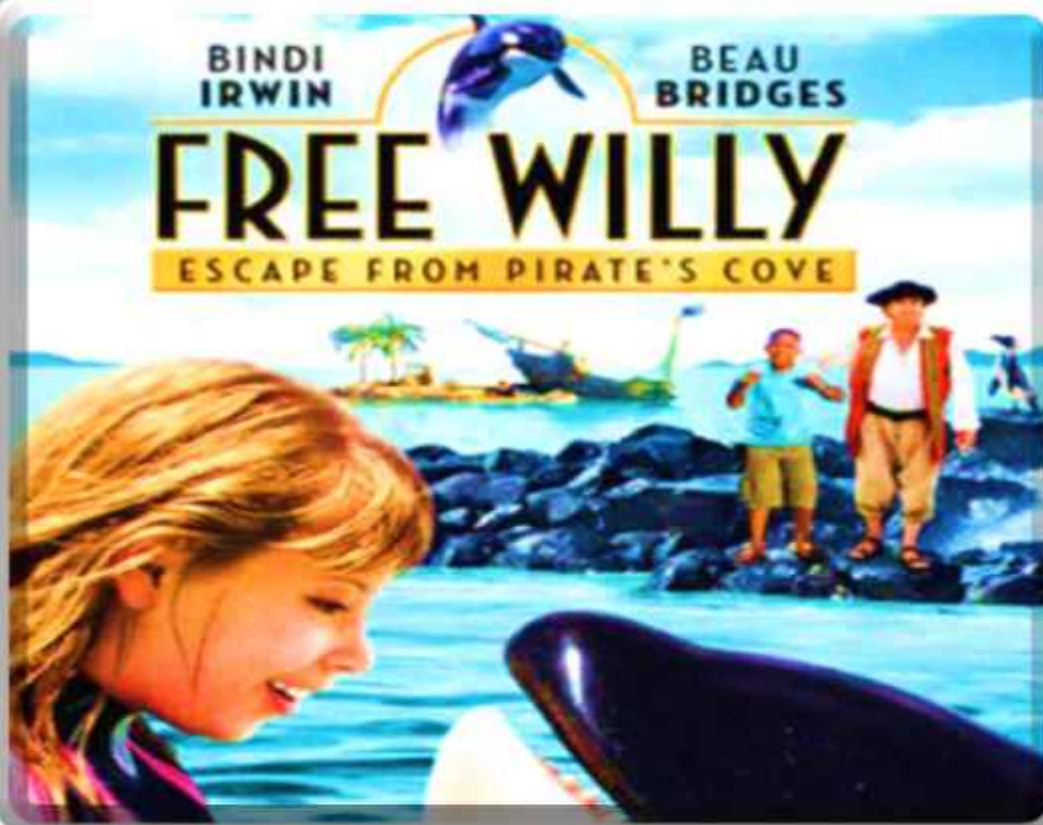
What is lovable about this story is that it is not a traditional “man saves the day” movie (not that there is anything wrong with that). Two sisters display what love between family members is all about.

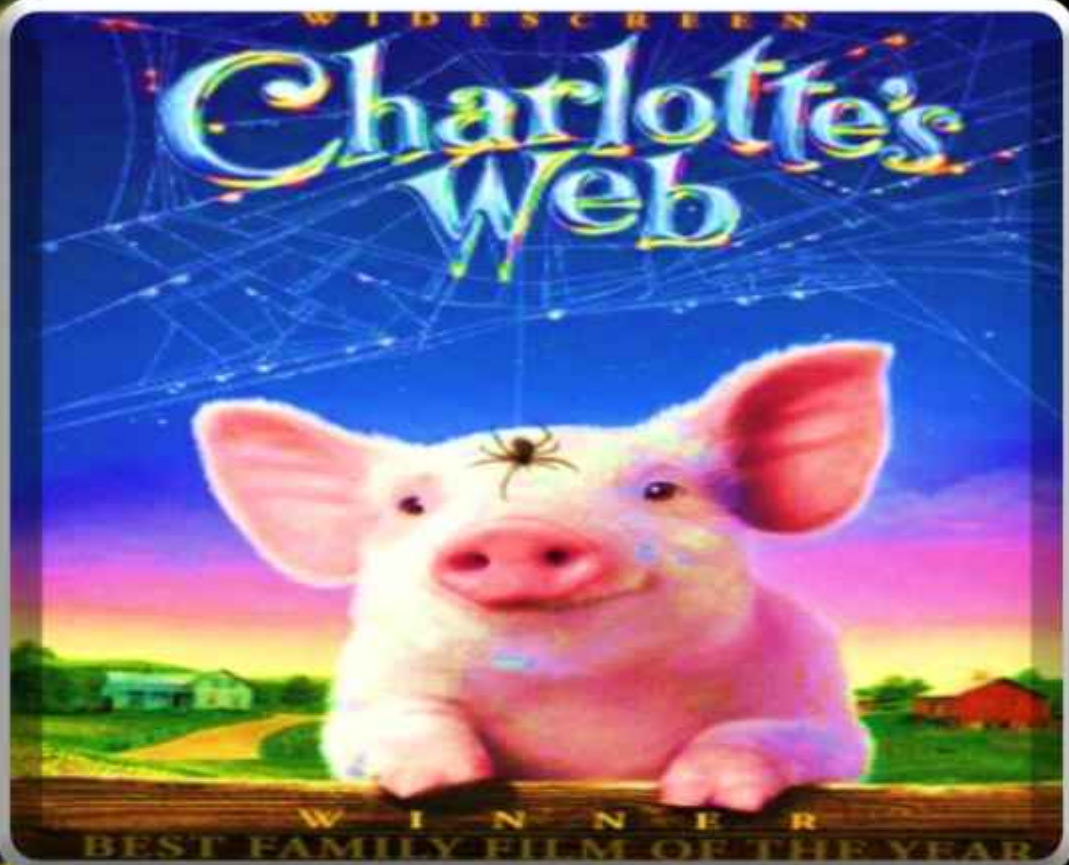
