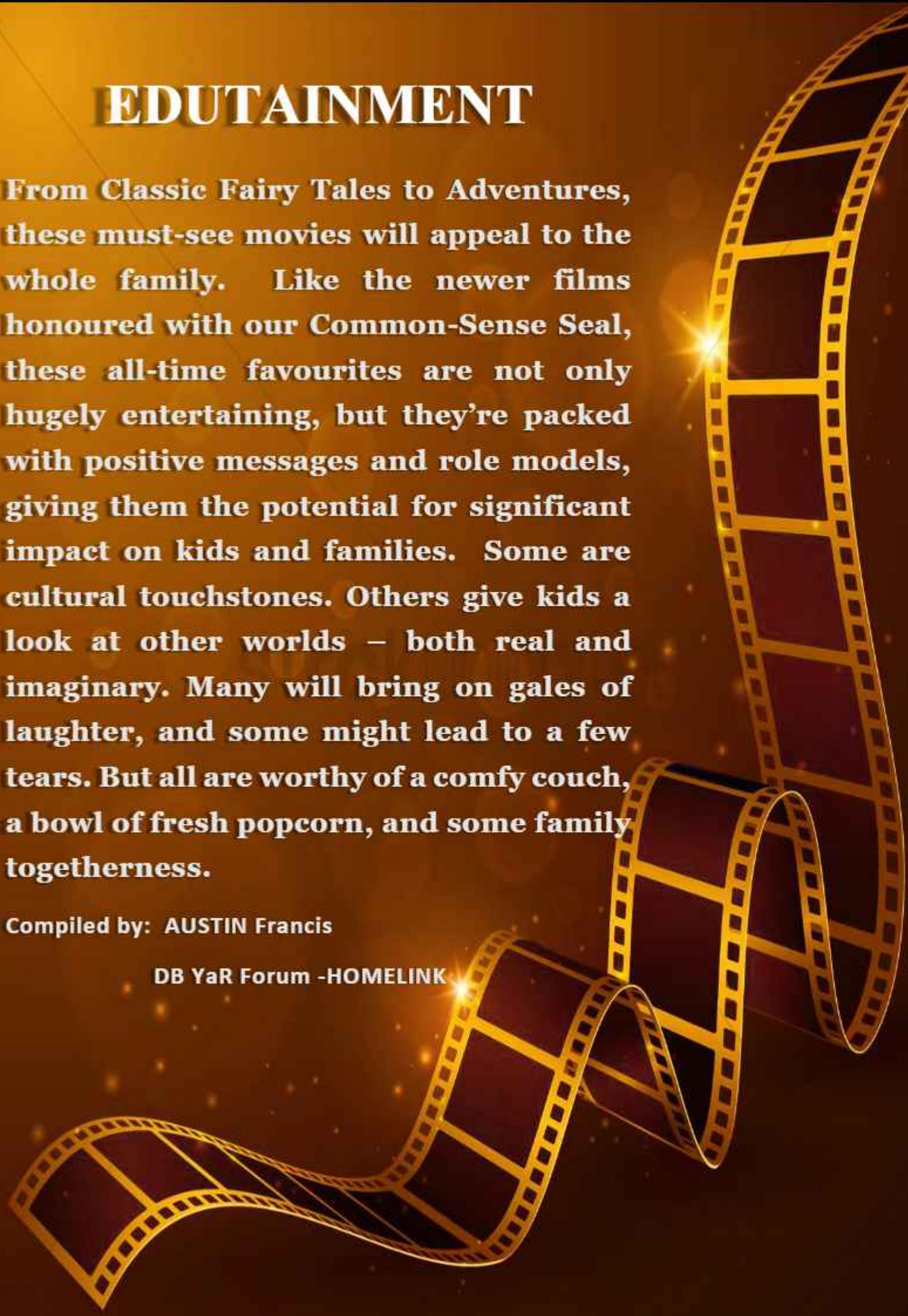

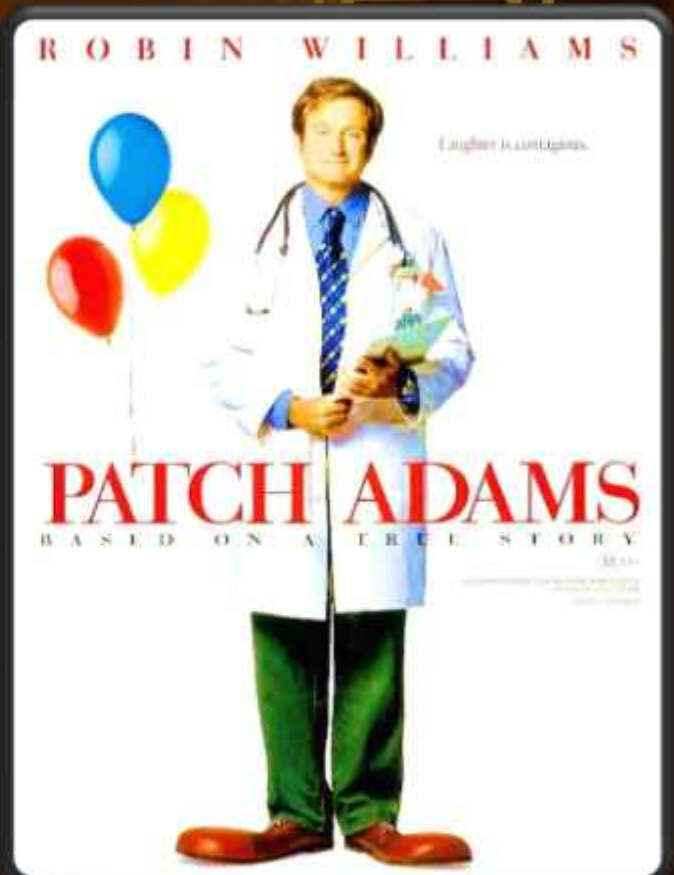

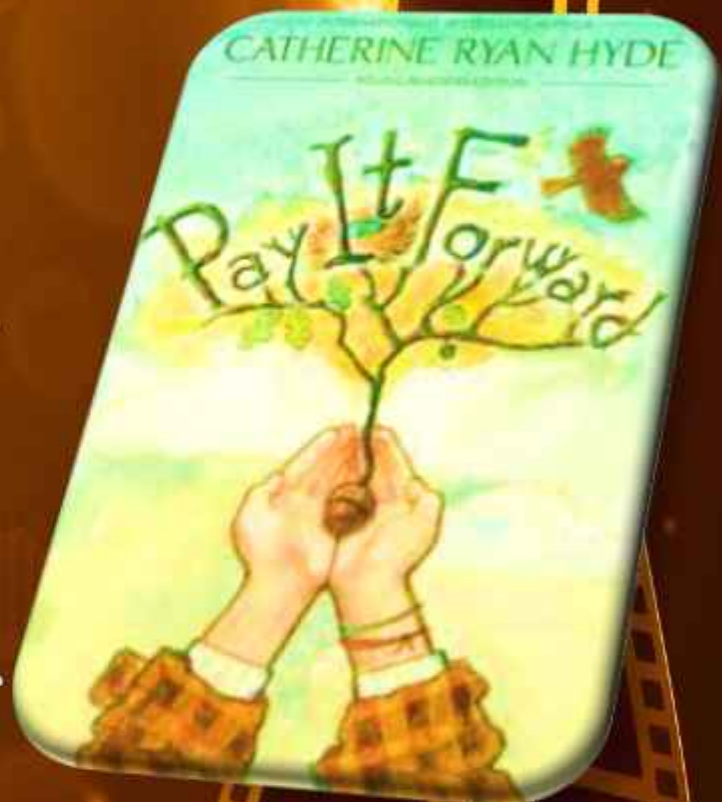
2. The PURSUIT of HAPPYNESS

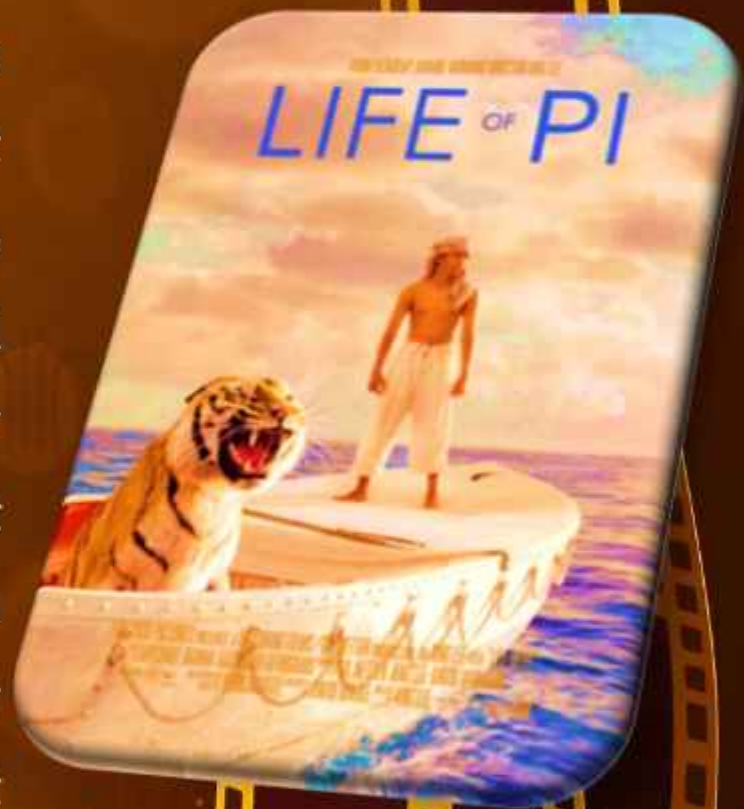
3. PAY IT FORWARD

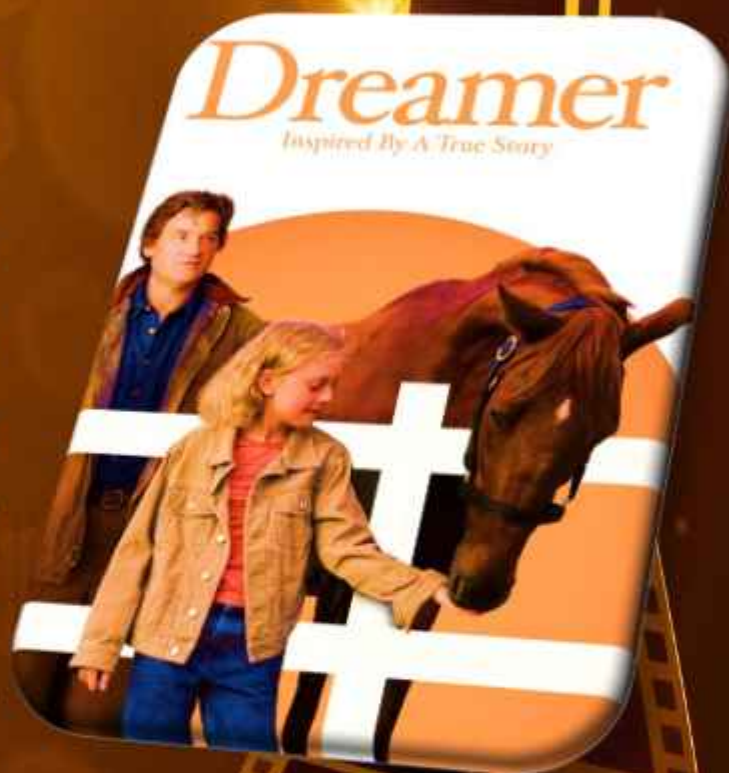
4. LIFE OF PI

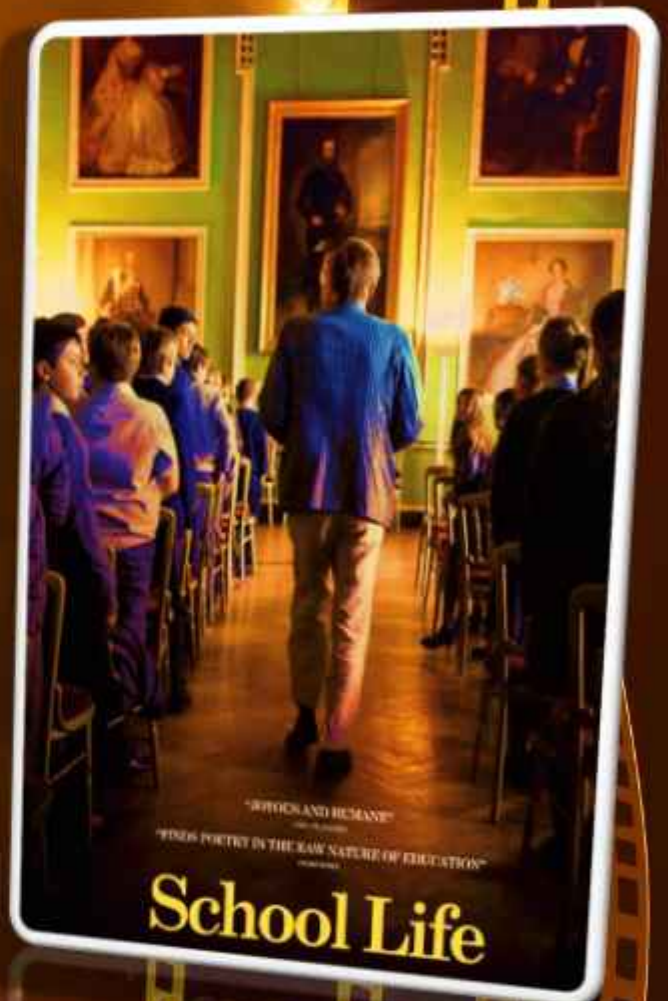
5. DREAMER

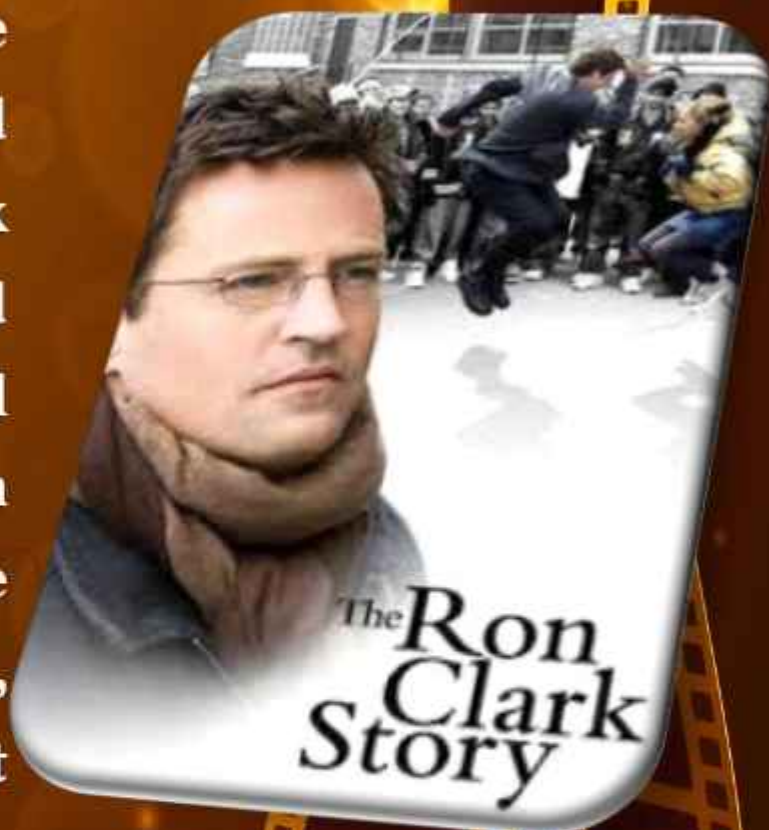
6. SCHOOL OF LIFE

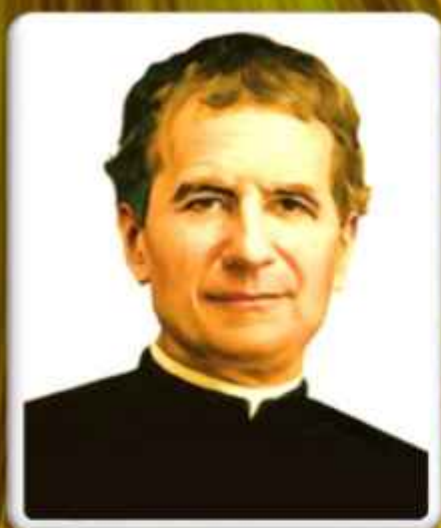
