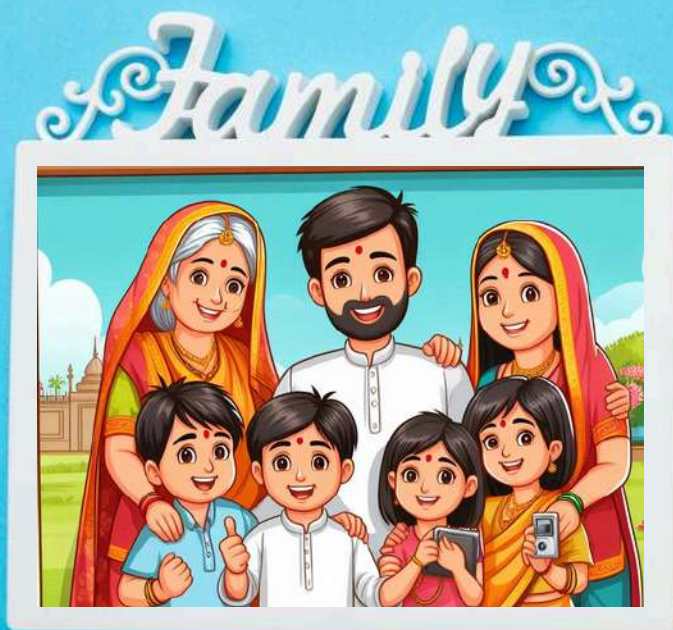

Rohan nodded, holding up his soccer ball. "And it's not just about winning—it's about trying your best and having fun."

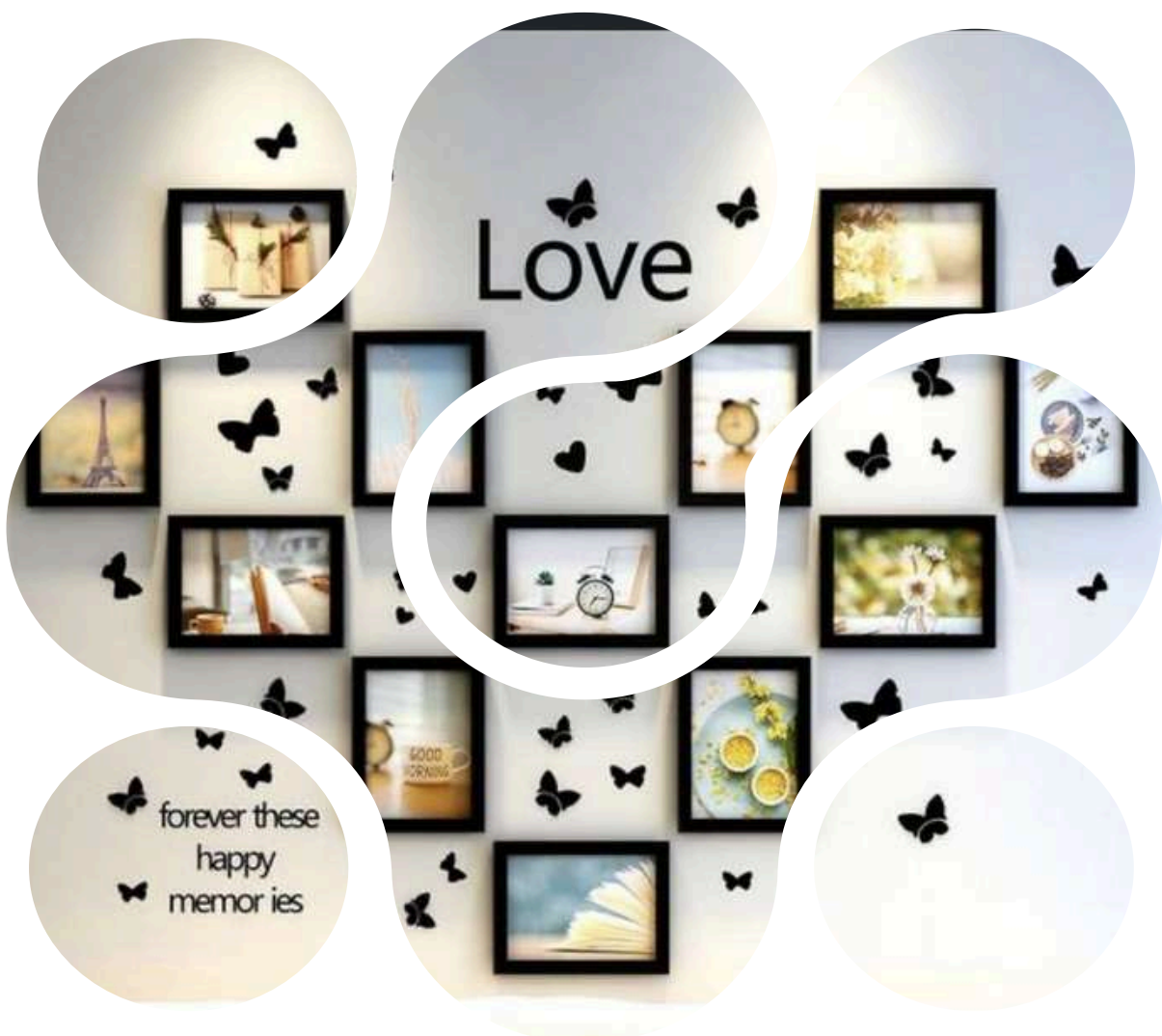
